## SPECIALIST LEADERS IN EDUCATION

Have you held a leadership responsibility in your school for two years or more?

Do you want to get involved in system leadership and have a positive impact on the lives of our young people?

**No? Then don't read this!**



If you're an experienced middle or senior leader who's interested in supporting middle and senior leaders in other schools, you may wish to apply to become a **specialist leader of education (SLE)**.

To become an NCTL designated SLE, you need to have been in a leadership role, other than head teacher, for at least 2 years. The role lasts for 4 years and moves with you should you decide to subsequently move schools.

### **What an SLE does**

This role is about developing the capacity and capability of other leaders so that they have the skills to lead their own teams and improve practice in their own schools.

You must have at least 1 specialism from NCTL's areas of expertise, which are based on the areas of focus in the Ofsted Common Inspection Framework (Sept 2016).
