

**TITLE: Identifying and supporting students with low level literacy and dyslexia.**

<b>Course Details:</b>	It is recognised that a child/young person with dyslexia can demonstrate marked differences between their attainments and their skills in different areas, particularly oral versus text based skills – and that recognising the learner’s strengths can increase their success and engagement with learning. This course examines practical ways of identifying the signs and symptoms of dyslexia and combines the mechanisms with practical advice for support and an introduction to literacy screening.
