



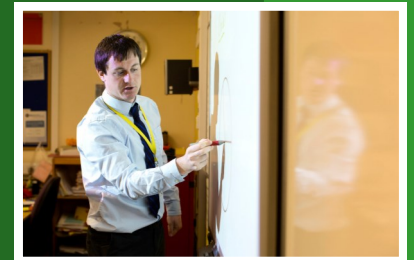
The Outstanding Teacher Programme (OTP)
